



Millage Reduction

Ballot Language is dictated by the State of Michigan.
The 2.25 millage on the ballot is in fact a *decrease*
from the current voter approved millage of 2.55
which is set to expire at end of 2021.

We would like to take this time to thank the community for your support since 1966. Canal View - Houghton County serves a role in our community and is vital to an aging population, which is expected to double for those over age 65 by 2040. The millage accounts for about 10 percent of the facilities' revenue. Keweenaw County, which has 15 beds in the facility, also provides support through a millage.

The millage helps pay the Maintenance of Effort bill to the State of Michigan which is based on the number of days billed to Medicaid each year. The Maintenance of Effort is a County obligation and it's currently paid by the facility using funds from the millage, averaging about \$450,000 per year.
